I want to take a moment and thank the Lord for His divine protection. Jan and I had an opportunity to attend the funeral for Rev. Eugene Cole, former Minister of Music at our church. We returned home from Morganton, North Carolina on I-77. I was driving about seventy miles an hour when a dual-wheel pick-up truck passed us doing at least eighty. As the truck pulled ahead of us one of his tires blew out. The force of the blowout drove the truck into the median between the north and south lanes. The lanes were divided by a cable held in place with metal stakes. The truck took down several feet of that barrier and was headed toward the south bound lane but the driver was able to keep the truck from swerving into the path of oncoming cars. It finally came to rest in the grass several hundred feet from where the blowout occurred. A large piece of the blown tire flew up and made its way toward our car. The tire struck the front of our car, but by the grace of God it did not cause us to wreck. Needless to say, Jan and I thanked God for His care for us, the other driver, and countless others on the road that day.

Do you realize that God is always watching over His children? Not just to see what we are doing, but to protect and care for us. The Bible tells us, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble" (Ps 46:1). God is the One we can run to for protection and safety (refuge). He is the One we can go to when we need the wisdom or power (strength) to deal with life's threats. He is the One we can go to and find peace, love, and grace (help) in times of trouble. Whether we know it or not, we need God! If you do not need Him right now, you certainly will sometime in the future. Don't wait until that moment arrives. Take the steps right now to insure that He will be with you in any and all situations. Trust Him to be your Savior. Ask Him to forgive you of your sins. Commit to follow Him as your Lord for the rest of your life. I promise, you will be glad you did. In closing, let me remind you to thank God each day for His divine protection. Blessings in Christ.

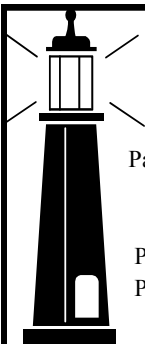
