His folks. The other day, I got my truck inspect-Puller ed. On the way home from the mechanic, the truck stopped running. I could not get it started no matter what I did. Eventually, I had to call a tow truck to take it back to people who had just inspected it. The truck did not stop working because of anything the mechanic did or did not do. It needed to be checked from top to bottom to discover what made it stop working.

I wonder if we ever perform a thorough evaluation of how we are doing spiritually. Something tells me that, like my truck, we don't have a spiritual inspection until something fails in our lives. However, if we wait until something is no longer working, it may be too late. It is a lot easier to change a habit, repair a relationship, avoid a sickness, and trust the Lord if we take steps to ensure it does not fail to begin with.

The Bible says, "Examine yourselves to see if your faith is genuine. Test yourselves. Surely you know that Jesus Christ is among you; if not, you have failed the test of genuine faith" (2 Corinthians 13:5). How do we perform a spiritual inspection on ourselves? Ask yourself the following questions:

Have I put my faith in Christ alone to save me?
Have I fully surrendered to the Holy Spirit?
Am I trusting in Christ and walking with Him daily?
Do I long to know God better today than yesterday?
Am I loving my neighbor the way Christ instructed?
Do I spend my time in ways that impact my church and community?

Am I spending appropriate time praying, reading, and meditating on the Word?

Do I obey God because of my <u>reverence</u> and gratitude for His love, or out of guilt or fear?

The ability to experience a thriving spiritual life requires we love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mk. 12:30). Don't wait, perform a personal spiritual inspection today. Blessings in Christ.




Loving Hands Ministry Meet Every Thursday of the month 10:00am-12:00 noon 2nd Floor Loving Hands Ministry Room #216




As of today, we have one tote full plus more! We hope to get it delivered sometime next week!
