#### DON'T PANIC

For the I got the idea for this article from a devotional produced by Dr. Robert Jeffress, Pastor of First Baptist Dallas (Pathway Magazine, April/ May, 2024, pp. 23-24). Hopefully, it will help you.

The world we live in often seems out of control. In the midst of chaos we can easily become distracted by things that we are powerless to do anything about. This frustrates us and adds to the chaos of the moment.

At the start of WWII, the British government printed posters to encourage its citizens. One was printed in case the Nazis invaded Britain. It said, "Keep Calm and Carry On." That's good advice for us today, but how do we do that?

First, we must be <u>disciplined</u> in what we allow into our minds. Paul said that before being saved we were slaves to our evil thoughts (Ro. 6:19). Those evil thoughts are what compelled us to sin. However, as believers we have the ability to live righteous lives. This is accomplished by "taking every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5). Don't allow evil thoughts to take up residence in your mind. Control your thoughts and you control your actions.

Second, we need to be <u>diligent</u> in what we allow into our minds. In the midst of chaos filling our thoughts with God's word keeps us from fear and distraction. Paul encouraged believers to think about things that are "true, honorable, right, pure, lovely, good, excellent, and worthy of praise" (Phil. 4:8). Thinking on these type of things will provide peace in the midst of chaos.

Never forget that our God is sovereign. He is always in control of what is happening in this world. He has complete authority over creation. And His power is unlimited. If we will think on the things of God and the truths contained in the Scripture, we can "keep calm and carry on" in the worst of times.


#### 1,000 SHOEBOXES Our Goal for 2024




## Fall Ladies Bible Study "HOSEA"
