Tough Love

Fatter Hi folks. Most of us have heard about "tough love". Perhaps some of you have even had to apply tough love to someone near and dear to you. That is, you chose to respond to them in a way that may have looked like you did not love them at that time, but it was for their own good. Did you know that God practices tough love? Read 2 Samuel 24.

God was upset with David for taking a census of Hebrew men who were capable of joining the army in the event of an enemy attack. In God's way of thinking, David trusted 800,000 soldiers (v.9) more than he did his God. After the census, David was convicted in his heart that he had sinned against God. So he asked the Lord to forgive him. In response to his prayer God sent the prophet Gad to David with 3 options (v.13): for his sin the nation would have 7 years of famine, or David would be pursued by his enemies for 3 months, or there would be 3 days of pestilence in the land. This was David's response, "Let us now fall into the hand of the LORD for His mercies are great, but do not let me fall into the hands of man" (v.14). David wanted God to punish him because He would have mercy. This resulted in the death of 70,000 Hebrew men (v.15).

The word "mercies" in verse 14 is the Hebrew word for compassion. Yes, God is just and righteous in His judgment, but even God's judgment is tempered by His love. Since God is love (1 Jn. 4:8); He never ceases to be love. Therefore, everything He does contains a strand of love. When God disciplines His children (Heb. 12:7-11) it is because He loves them and wants what is best for them. God never ceases to love, regardless of what we do.

As you prepare to celebrate Valentine's Day, remember the love God has for you. Jeremiah wrote, "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. ²³ Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning" (Lam. 3:22-23, NLT). Perhaps those who are special to you could use a dose of God's type of love this holiday. Blessings in Christ.
